

Summary of Changes in the TBAR Points Series Rules

Effective March March 1, 2010

(new text in red)

Article I Add three categories;

Junior Women (10-14)

Junior Women (15-16)

Junior Women (17-18)

2.6 Increase rider fee

Event promoter(s) must pay a ~~\$1.00~~ \$2.00 per rider fee to TBRA for every participant registered in every event, excluding Juniors. This fee applies to both points series races and non series races. In addition it is strongly recommended that Juniors be charged a race entry fee of insurance cost only.

2.10 Clarification of categories required for each event.

2.10 Event Promoters will make provisions to allow all members of a TBRA TBAR competition category to compete and provide separate results for each category. in a single event (i.e. Senior Men Category Pro/ Cat 1, Senior Women Category 1-3, etc.). This does not mean all events must have races for each TBAR Category. (NOTE: In races where TBAR categories/classes are combined points will be awarded on overall position. If a separate prize list is provided by category/class then points will be awarded to the top riders in each category/class. A prize list can take the form of a Bonus (e.g. Pro 1/2 race with a bonus for category 2 will generate two points lists whereas a Pro 1/2 race without a bonus will generate a single combined points list).

3.10 Restore free entry for BAR Champions in Division I races.

3.10 Winners of each category will be awarded a TBAR Series Champion's Jersey and Current TBAR Champions who pre-register for Division I races by the specified closing date shall be refunded their entry fee provided that they wear their championship jersey in the race.

3.13 Change to allow BAR awards at the last race.

3.13 All BAR awards to be awarded at the final event or awards banquet with jerseys ordered and shipped afterward.

Article II 1. Change to clarify masters eligibility at the state championships and to award state championship medals at the state championship event.

1 A Tennessee State Championship jersey will be awarded to the highest placing Tennessee licensed rider in each road event (road race, criterium, and time trial), for each category and age group competition recognized by TBRA. Eligibility to be the same as the TBAR series. All state championship medals to be awarded at the championship event with jerseys ordered and shipped after the event.

2. Add team time trial state championships.

2 A Tennessee State Championship circulating trophy will be awarded to the club time trial team for each category recognized by TBRA. Team to be 3 to 5 riders registered to the same club.
